## NJEDA PRODUCTS FOR SMALL BUSINESSES MANUFACTURERS



#### Direct & Premier Lending

Loans up to \$2M for fixed assets or \$750K working capital for New Jersey businesses in need of financing and committed to job creation/retention when conventional financing is not available.



#### Small Business Improvement Grant

Reimburses business owners 50% of costs (up to \$50K) associated with making interior and/or exterior building improvements, and/or purchasing/installing new furniture, fixtures, and/or equipment.



#### **Small Business Fund**

Creditworthy small, minorityowned or women-owned business in New Jersey in operation for at least one full year who may not have the ability to get bank financing, or not-for-profit corporation in operation for at least three full years. Financing can be used for fixed assets or working capital.

#### NJ Rise

The \$20 million NJ RISE Program will provide grants to companies to relocate its New Jersey-resident employees, ensuring a residents' income taxes stay in New Jersey, which will help increase tax revenue.



Financing for creditworthy manufacturing companies, 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organizations, and exempt facilities in state.



#### New Jersey Innovation Evergreen Fund (NJIEF)

The Evergreen Program secures funding and strategic support from a **corporate tax credit auction**, then partners with private venture capital firms to co-invest the funds in eligible early stage businesses in New Jersey.

(September 12, 2024) – Yesterday, the NJEDA's Board approved Phase III of the **Manufacturing Voucher Program** (MVP), dedicating an additional \$10 million to support manufacturers access to new equipment. To date, the NJEDA has committed nearly \$50 million to over 325 manufacturers under MVP.


