New Jersey Re-Assigning In-State Employees (NJ RISE) Program

New Jersey Re-Assigning In-State Employees (NJ RISE) is an exciting pilot program offering \$20 million in grants to businesses. It incentivizes companies to reassign New Jersey residents working out-of-state to local NJ offices, keeping their income taxes in-state and boosting our tax revenue.

Apply on or before July 1st, 2028

Applications accepted on a rolling basis until funding is exhausted.

Employees can only be re-assigned after the grant application is submitted.

Eligibility:

- ► The business must have 25+ domestic full-time employees.
- Business principally located in another state that uses *Convenience of the Employer Income Taxation Rule* such as: Delaware, Nebraska, and New York.
- ▶ The business must submit an application to the NJEDA on or before July 1, 2028.
- ► The business must be in good standing with the NJ Department of Labor and Workforce Development (LWD) and NJ Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).
- ► The business must provide a current tax clearance certificate, which must be maintained through disbursement to demonstrate the applicant is properly registered to do business in NJ and in substantially good standing with the NJ Division of Taxation.

Certification Requirements:

Upon the submission of an independent CPA's certification of the gross withholdings, NJEDA will release, up to, 75% of the grant award. NJEDA will then verify the eligible employees' withholdings with the Division of Taxation and release the retained funds once confirmed.

Grant Award:

The grant amount is equal to the NJ Gross Income Tax Withholdings of re-assigned Employees subject to the maximum award of \$500,000 in the aggregate, per applicant. Employees are eligible only if they are re-assigned after submission of a grant application to the NJEDA.

Fees: Application Fee: \$5,000 Administrative Fee: \$1,000
